The Pool: Cooke Hall is a 25 yard, 6 lane pool with flat end walls and a 7' shallow end. The pool is fast, and is equipped with grabable starting blocks, backstroke flags, and good lane lines. There is plenty of bench seating around the pool and seating for about 1100 spectators.

The Cost: There will be a \$7.00 entry fee, which covers unlimited entry in the events, plus a gift of the Official Minnesota Masters Swimming Pin. The entry fee automatically places your name on the MMSC mailing list for one year, which includes all the Meet Notices, all meet results, and the Old Sternwheeler's Masters Newsletter.


